Good Faith Estimate Notice

Beginning in 2022, all self-pay clients will be provided with a good faith estimate within one business day of your first (intake or evaluation) appointment. (If you use insurance to pay for therapy, this notice does not apply to you).

Under the law, you have the right to receive a "Good Faith Estimate" explaining how much your medical care will cost. Your Estimate will be individualized according to your clinical needs and estimated length of treatment.

If you receive a bill that is at least \$400 more than your Good Faith Estimate, you can dispute the bill.

Make sure to save a copy or picture of your Good Faith Estimate once it is provided to you.
